

PLUM BROOK CHRONOLOGY

- 1940 U. S. ARMY ESTABLISHED PLUM BROOK ORDNANCE WORKS -- 9,000 ACRES ACQUIRED
- 1945 PLUM BROOK ORDNANCE WORKS CLOSED -- 3,000 ACRES RETURNED TO PUBLIC USE
- 1955 NACA ACQUIRED 500 ACRES FOR REACTOR SITE FROM U. S. ARMY
- 1963 NASA ACQUIRED BALANCE OF ACREAGE FROM U. S. ARMY FOR ROCKET SYSTEM AREA
- 1969-1970 NASA ACQUIRED AN ADDITIONAL 2,000 ACRES AS A BUFFER ZONE AROUND THE PERIMETER
- FALL 1972 NASA DECISION TO PHASE OUT PB OPERATIONS BASED ON PROGRAMMATIC CONSIDERATIONS
- JUNE 1973 - STATION PLACED IN STANDBY CONDITION
OCT 1975
- DEC 1976 LERC PROPOSED 4 OPTIONS REGARDING PLUM BROOK TO NASA HEADQUARTERS

PLUM BROOK CHRONOLOGY

- FEB 1977 NASA HEADQUARTERS ELECTS TO KEEP SPF, B-2, HTF, K-SITE, & REACTOR IN STANDBY, WTG & WAREHOUSING FACILITIES IN OPERATION, & RELEASE EXCESS LAND AND EQUIPMENT.
- SEP 1977 INITIATE ACTION TO DISPOSE OF 2150 ACRES OF EXCESS STATION LAND
- OCT 1978 INITIAL GARRETT REQUEST FOR USE OF SPF
- APR 1979 PRESENTATION MADE TO NASA ADMINISTRATOR REQUESTING DIRECTION ON THE FUTURE OF PLUM BROOK STATION
- JUN 1979 REACTOR DECOMMISSIONING & DISMANTLING PROJECT INITIATED
- NOV 1979 5-YEAR LEASE FINALIZED FOR GARRETT OCCUPATION OF SPF
- AUG 1980 \$1 MILLION APPROVED FOR 1st PHASE OF REACTOR DECOMMISSIONING
- MAY 1981 DISMANTLING ORDER FOR REACTOR FACILITY ISSUED BY NRC
- AUG 1981 GARRETT REQUEST FOR EXTENDED USE OF SPF

- APR 1983 1500 ACRES OF EXCESSED STATION BUFFER ZONE LAND SOLD BY GSA AUCTION TO PRIVATE SECTOR
- MAY 1984 10 ACRES NASA EXCESS PROPERTY SOLD BY GSA TO U.S. ARMY
- JUL 1984 LEWIS AUTHORITY GIVEN TO RAZE OBSOLETE RESEARCH TOWERS - B-1, B-3, & E
- SEP 1984 GARRETT LEASE EXTENDED THROUGH 1990
- SEP 1984 STUDY INITIATED TO DETERMINE STATUS AND RESIDUAL CONTAMINATION LEVELS OF REACTOR - COMPLETION 12-31-85
- OCT 1984 DECISION MADE NOT TO DISMANTLE REACTOR
- MAY 1985 DECISION MADE BY NASA/DOE TO TRANSFER OPERATIONS OF MQD-0 WTG FROM NASA TO SERI
- JUN 1985 GARRETT RECEIVED DOE NOTICE OF CENTRIFUGE PROGRAM TERMINATION AND GARRETT PHASE-DOWN COMMENCED
- JUL 1985 NRC NOTIFIED DISMANTLING ORDER FOR REACTOR TO BE CANCELLED BY NASA AND LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION INITIATED
- SEP 1985 DECISION MADE BY SERI/DOE TO DISCONTINUE OPERATIONS OF MOD-0 WTG AT PLUM BROOK STATION

PLUM BROOK CHRONOLOGY

NOVEMBER 22, 1985

1940 U.S. ARMY ESTABLISHED PLUM BROOK ORDNANCE WORKS - 9,000 ACRES ACQUIRED

1945 PLUM BROOK ORDNANCE WORKS CLOSED -- 3,000 ACRES ~~RETURNED TO PUBLIC USE~~ *Sold by GSA to Private*

1955 NACA ACQUIRED 500 ACRES FOR REACTOR SITE FROM U.S. ARMY THROUGH GSA

1963 NASA ACQUIRED BALANCE OF 5500 ACRES FROM U.S. ARMY THROUGH GSA FOR ROCKET SYSTEM AREAS *Station*

1969-1970 NASA ACQUIRED AN ADDITIONAL 2,000 ACRES AS A BUFFER ZONE ~~AROUND THE PERIMETER~~ *Adm. - 716*

FALL 1972 NASA DECISION TO PHASE OUT PB OPERATIONS BASED ON PROGRAMMATIC CONSIDERATIONS

Y JUN 1973-OCT 1975 STATION PLACED IN STANDBY CONDITION *Station*

DEC 1976 LeRC PROPOSED 4 OPTIONS REGARDING PLUM BROOK TO NASA HEADQUARTERS

FEB 1977 DECISION BY NASA HEADQUARTERS AND LEWIS TO RETAIN SPF, B-2, HTF, K-SITE, AND REACTOR IN STANDBY; WTG AND WAREHOUSING FACILITIES IN OPERATION; AND RELEASE EXCESS LAND AND EQUIPMENT.

SEP 1977 INITIATE ACTION TO DISPOSE OF 2150 ACRES OF EXCESS STATION LAND

JUN 1978 36 ACRES OF EXCESSED NASA PROPERTY TRANSFERRED BY GSA TO PERKINS SCHOOL SYSTEM

OCT 1978 INITIAL GARRETT REQUEST FOR USE OF SPACE POWER FACILITY

APR 1979 PRESENTATION MADE TO NASA ADMINISTRATOR REQUESTING DIRECTION ON THE FUTURE OF PLUM BROOK STATION

JUN 1979 REACTOR DECOMMISSIONING AND DISMANTLING PROJECT INITIATED

NOV 1979 FIVE-YEAR LEASE FINALIZED FOR GARRETT OCCUPATION OF SPF

AUG 1980 \$1 MILLION APPROVED FOR 1ST PHASE OF REACTOR DECOMMISSIONING

X OCT 1980 EXCESSED ADDITIONAL 143 ACRES OF PLUM BROOK STATION LAND TO GSA

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MAY 1981 DISMANTLING ORDER FOR REACTOR FACILITY ISSUED BY NRC

AUG 1981 GARRETT REQUEST FOR EXTENDED USE OF SPF

APR 1983 1500 ACRES OF EXCESSED STATION BUFFER ZONE LAND SOLD BY GSA AUCTION TO PRIVATE SECTOR

NOV 1983 32 ACRES EXCESSED STATION PROPERTY TRANSFERRED TO STATE OF OHIO HISTORICAL ASSOCIATION, OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

MAY 1984 10 ACRES NASA EXCESS PROPERTY SOLD BY GSA TO U.S. ARMY

JUL 1984 LEWIS AUTHORITY GIVEN TO RAZE OBSOLETE RESEARCH TOWERS - B-1, B-3, AND E - ~~R. 501~~

SEP 1984 GARRETT LEASE EXTENDED THROUGH 1990

SEP 1984 STUDY INITIATED TO DETERMINE STATUS AND RESIDUAL CONTAMINATION LEVELS OF REACTOR - COMPLETION SCHEDULED FOR DECEMBER 31, 1985

OCT 1984 DECISION MADE NOT TO DISMANTLE REACTOR

MAY 1985 DECISION MADE BY NASA/DOE TO TRANSFER OPERATIONS OF MOD-0 WTG FROM NASA TO SERI

JUN 1985 GARRETT RECEIVED DOE NOTICE OF CENTRIFUGE PROGRAM TERMINATION AND GARRETT PHASE-DOWN COMMENCED

JUL 1985 NRC NOTIFIED DISMANTLING ORDER FOR REACTOR TO BE CANCELLED BY NASA AND LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION INITIATED - NRC APPROVAL PENDING

JUL 1985 RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLIANCE WITH NRC REQUIREMENTS TRANSFERRED TO PLUM BROOK MANAGEMENT OFFICE

SEP 1985 DECISION MADE BY SERI/DOE TO DISCONTINUE OPERATIONS OF MOD-0 WTG AT PLUM BROOK STATION

OCT 1985 SERI/DOE SEP 1985 DECISION REVERSED AND MOD-0 WTG OPERATIONS TENTATIVELY EXTENDED THROUGH JUN 1986
